

# TUTORIAL GARLIC

## WHAT YOU NEED:



- **Polymer Clay:** Champagne / White
- Tools as from photo
- Blade
- Beige Cotton thread
- Glue
- Tile



**STEP 1:** You take a piece of polymer white clay and model to little ball giving her shape lengthened as in the photo. It will be the stem of the garlic.



**STEP 2 and STEP 3:** You use the tool and you engrave the little ball of polymer clay with two perpendicular cuts.



**STEP 4:** You take a piece of beige polymer clay and, with the help of the blade, very fine mince it.



**STEP 5:** You apply a point of glue in the center of the little ball, and with the help of an angle of the blade, or, if you prefer one tooth-pick, you glue in irregular way the little pieces minced of beige polymer clay. In alternative you can use some straw threads. To cook in oven to 130 grades for about 20 minutes.
