

TUTORIAL MUSHROOM

WHAT YOU NEED:



- **Polymer Clay:** Champagne / Terracotta
- Tools (see photo)
- Blade
- Tile



STEP 1: With a small piece of polymer clay Champagne form a little ball of around half centimeter of diameter



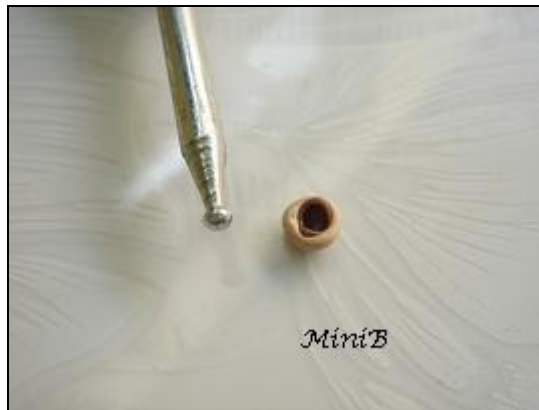
STEP 2: You use the tool with round extremity and you engrave the little ball. So. you've got the hat of the mushroom!. Do this on the finger or on soft material, otherwise the inferior part become flat (and not rounded).



STEP 3: Follow the same procedure of the STEP 1 with the polymer clay Terracotta. Model a ball smaller than the preceding one.



STEP 4: Insert the little ball Terracotta in the hollow.



STEP 5: With the tool with round extremity, you slightly crush the little ball Terracotta.



STEP 6: . Now use the tool with flat extremity and engrave some cross lines.



STEP 7: Take some Fimo Champagne and cut a small piece. This will be the stem of the mushroom!



STEP 8: Insert the stem you've obtained in the center of the hat. Try to slightly model every different mushroom from the precedent, you give different anglings to the stems.



STEP 9: Here are your mushrooms!
If you want, you can dirty with some brown color the base of the stem to imitate the earth. Cook the synthetic pasta in oven (around 130° for 20 minutes).////
